

Project Mileposts



FEBRUARY 2011

Beaver asks BAHF to consider repurposing the 911 Center property acquired from Beaver County. Study Group formed.

SEPTEMBER 2011

Beaver Borough train station grant used to engage historic preservation architect Pfaffmann + Associates for adaptive reuse study.

JULY 2012

BAHF board approves Beaver Station plans and authorizes capital campaign.

MAY 2013

Campaign reaches \$650,000. Property is purchased from Beaver Borough.

JULY 2013

Beaver County Genealogy & History Center opens in the lower level "bunker."

DECEMBER 2013

\$700,000 Pennsylvania RACP Grant awarded bringing campaign total to \$1,535,000.

MAY 2014

LC Renninger Group named construction manager. Pennsylvania Historic and Museum Commission Grant awarded for \$50,000.

OCTOBER 2014

Slate roof work completed. Major construction begins. Woman's Club of Beaver becomes 200th donor with a \$10,000 gift.

JUNE 2015

Building rehabilitation nearing completion. \$500,000 grant received from the Allegheny Foundation, a recognized leader in historic preservation efforts.

OCTOBER 2015

Beaver Station opens for limited public use. Over 290 donors have now contributed over \$2,510,000.

2016

Sweetwater art classes begin and BAHM Collection & Research Center in full operation. Over 100 events take place in the 1897 Event Room. Porte Cochere, Belvedere and other site features completed. By late in the year over 350 donors had contributed \$2,725,000.

2017

History of Beaver County educational display planned for the north lawn. Campaign ends and donor appreciation plaques installed.
